

INFORMATION SHEET

on the allocation of grants from the Corona emergency aid fund of the Studierendenwerk Greifswald

A subsidy can be given to anyone who is in economic need through no fault of their own. Beginning from Monday, April 27, 2020, applications for funds from the newly created Corona Emergency Aid Fund can be submitted. The financial resources currently available are limited and are to be increased through a joint call for donations with the universities.

1. Confinement of Intended Purpose

- This emergency aid fund is intended to provide short-term and unbureaucratic help to ensure livelihood (the cost of living = food, accommodation and health care).
- The financial aid is usually used to compensate for lost or impossible income or Third party payments.
- The parallel use of financial support by different institutions should be avoided. As a rule, the level of need is based on the principles of BAföG.

2. Amount of Disbursal

- The amount of the funding is usually € 200.00 per month as a grant. Deviations up and down are possible in justified cases due to special social situations.

3. Allocation/Decision

- Allowing is granted without legal entitlement in accordance to the documented emergency and the means available.
- The decision is made on the basis of the submitted application form together with complete annexes (always by four-eyes principle).

4. Application and advice

- Advice on how to apply can be made by phone or email via the social counselling service provided by the Studierendenwerk Greifswald.
